
# Hugh Tracey Chromatic Kalimbas

Double-sided Chromatic Kalimbas have the "flats" on the back side which are played with the fingers.

The pentatonic scale is a simplified scale. Hugh Tracey found that about 40% of African kalimbas were pentatonic.

# Children and the Kalimba

While most of the kalimbas we sell are great instruments for both experienced musicians and non-musical adults, don't overlook the kids! Playing kalimba is like an anchor in the real world, a counterweight against the force of "screen time." While every person is different and will be ready for a different kalimba adventure, I make the general suggestion that you match the number of tines on the kalimba to the child's age. For example, a 9-note kalimba for a nine-year-old kid.

When I started playing kalimba in 1986, I was on my own. There was essentially no information out there on how to play kalimba. Then came the World Wide Web in the early 1990s - and I thought surely someone would post information on how to play kalimba. #### Kalimba Tablature




Kalimba tablature is a representational map of the kalimba, with the notes placed on the tines you must play to accomplish a particular song. It is read starting at the bottom.

This is an elegant system that can be generalized to almost any type of kalimba.


The tablature may look daunting at first, but children as young as six years old can read tablature. Just go as slowly as you need at first. As you gain familiarity, you will gain speed.

I have written over 40 kalimba books and instructional downloads for more than a dozen different types of kalimba. Tablature has become essential to the creation, teaching, and sharing of this music.




"Joy to the World" on 8-Note Kalimba
